LEGALISING GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS



Visit the Singapore Academy of Law's Legalisation portal at **https://legalisation.sal.sg.** Enter the details of the documents that need to be legalised and make payment online*

LEGALISING NON-GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS



Notarise your document at your preferred Notary Public and inform them that you will need it legalised. Your document will need to be authenticated by SAL after notarisation by the Notary Public.

Visit the Singapore Academy of Law from 9:00am to 4:30pm, Mondays to Fridays, to have your document legalised.

At SAL, your document will be affixed with an Apostille, so that the document will be accepted in an official capacity when presented to a person, company or authority outside of Singapore.

- Is your document heading to a contracting party of the Apostille Convention? It needs no further checks after this and can go straight to your recipient.
- Is your document heading to a noncontracting party of the Apostille Convention?
 Present it to the consular section of the mission representing that country.
